Class CA- Hairdressing Program:

This course is A program that prepares individuals to shampoo, cut, style, set, and dress the scalp hair of women and/or men, braid hair, apply hair cosmetics and wigs, and prepare for licensure as professional cosmetologists, and hairdressers at various levels. Includes instruction in hair design theory and concepts, hair cleaning and shampooing, hair coloring, chemical applications and permanent reconstructions, hair anatomy and physiology, scalp diseases and treatments, wig and hairpiece fitting, hair braiding, customer service, shop management, equipment operation, health and safety, and applicable laws and regulations. It should be noted that the program costs include the costs of the state's Practical and Theory License Exam, which are required to be passed by the graduate prior to being employable in the field. To take the State License Exam, a student must graduate from a 1500-hour program approved by the State Board of Cosmetology. The length of our 1500 hour approved program is estimated at 52 weeks. This program includes remote learning/distance education activity hours, up to 50% of total theory program hours. Distance Education activities include contemporaneously, visually and verbally interactions between the instructor and student learning through zoom and online interactive CIMA software.

Objectives of the program include:

1. Introduces student to the knowledge, and understanding of the theory of hair design, as well as the skill and appreciation of the practice of hair styling and design.
2. A program that prepares individuals to shampoo, cut, style, set, and dress the scalp hair of women and/or men, braid hair, apply hair cosmetics and wigs, and prepare for licensure as professional cosmetologists, hairdressers, and barbers at various levels.
3. Introduces instruction in hair design theory and concepts, hair cleaning and shampooing, hair coloring, chemical applications and permanent reconstructions, wig and hairpiece fitting, hair braiding
4. To develop knowledge in customer service, health and safety, and applicable laws and regulations.
5. To prepare the student for the State Board Examination and obtain a license to practice Hair Styling.
